- D. Blankenship called the meeting to order.
- D. Reese made a motion to approve the minutes from the Jan. 14 regular meeting, Jan. 25 executive meeting, Jan 30 special meeting and Feb. 8, 2020 executive meeting. R. Wells seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- T. Hunt said Cornerstone proposal for installation of pump \$20,800.00. Pump through PVP Pump is \$19,665.00. American Pump & Service, Inc quote for repairing pump \$3,603.00 and get new pump \$5,469.00. R. Wells made a motion to purchase a new pump from American Pump Repair & Service, Inc for \$5,469.00. D.
