Meghan Deckman arrived.



The Clerk is concerned about the Water Department Funds and paying for this and additional repairs that have been approved. Discussion followed. Daniel Blankenship made a motion to approve the quote from Peerless Midwest inc. for \$137,200.00. The invoice is to be paid as follows: \$68,600.00 from ARP Funds and \$68,600.00 from Water Department Funds. Dustin Reese made a motion to sign the quote from Peerless Midwest Inc. for \$137,200.00. Teresa Welsh seconded the motion. Vote was 5/0. Motion carried.

Nick Rice mentioned the possible Railroad strike which will affect getting chlorine. Discussion followed. The Council wants at least seven cylinders of chlorine ordered. So, we have plenty.

There being no further business to be brought before the Council at this time. Dustin Reese made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Teresa Welsh seconded the motion. Vote was 5/0. Motion carried.
